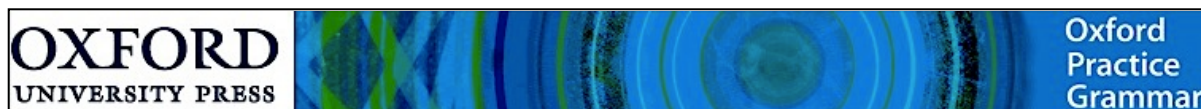
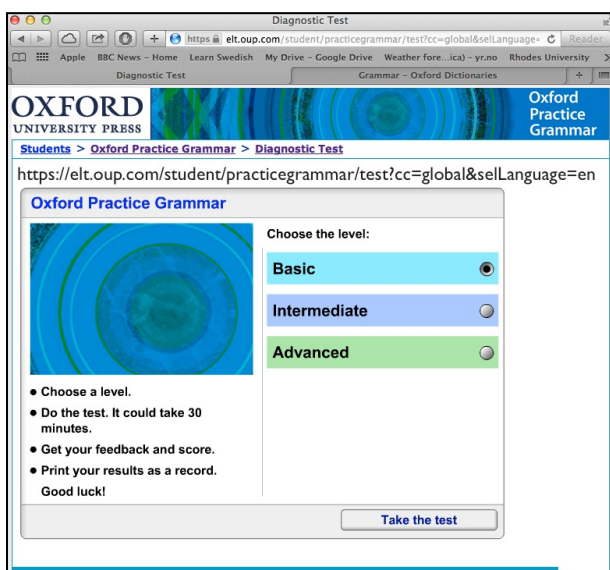


IMPROVING YOUR ENGLISH

Once you have completed the test you will get your results. Follow the link in the table for advice on how to improve. It will take you to the Oxford Practice Grammar Exercises. You can see from the screenshot that my score was only 88% and I need to improve my modal verbs.

The screenshot shows I navigated to the section on verbs as that was a place for improvement that the test highlighted.

The test can take you 30 minutes (I did it as quickly as I possibly could and it took me six minutes). There are 100 questions divided into sections: tenses, propositions, verbs etc.
